- · Unlimited contact via email or phone
- Contact all vendors to confirm orders, guest count and logistics 30 days prior to the wedding
- Attend final meetings with the venue and catering managers
- · Create your floor plan
- Collaborate with all vendors to create your day of itinerary
- One hour rehearsal and review of the day of itinerary with the wedding party
- Full Day of Coordination with a minimum of two coordinators
- · Act as point of contact for all vendors
- Manage the day of timeline with photography, hair and makeup, and transportation to get you down the aisle on time

- Distribute bouquets and pin boutonnieres
- Line up wedding party for the ceremony, manage the procession and post ceremony photos and transportation
- Stage décor items at the ceremony, cocktail hour and or reception to include but not limited to signs, place cards, cake knife, favors, table numbers etc. (items provided by couple)
- Meet vendors to oversee ceremony and reception set up
- Manage the reception timeline with caterer, photographer, and entertainment to ensure a seamless event
- · Distribute tips to vendors
- Distribute gifts and décor items to the designated person following the event.
- · Oversee vendor teardown
- Ensure reimbursement of security deposits





The Mext Steps

ONE Schedule Consultation
